- Date:** Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> December.  
**Cost:** £4.00 per Cub  
**Location:** Bentley Copse Scout Campsite, Hound House Road, Shere, GU5 9JH  
**Meet Time:** Between 10.00 and 10.15am  
**Arriving:** Upon arrival in the campsite car park, Cubs should make their way to the "Morrow Centre" located to the left on the main field.  
**Uniform:** Cubs should wear top half of uniform, with suitable trousers and footwear. Please wear suitable outer coats/gloves/hat etc. to reflect the prevailing weather on the day, bearing in mind that most of the day will be spent outdoors.  
**Required:** Everyone will need to bring uncooked sausages with bread rolls for their lunch, plus a camp mug suitable for hot drinks.  
**Included:** At ChillyCub, everyone will take part in wide games, build and light fires under supervision, cook their sausages for lunch, and attend a short Scouts Own Christmas service in the campsite chapel. There will also be soup and hot drinks available throughout the day.  
**Collection:** ChillyCub finishes at 3:00pm. Cubs should be collected from the Morrow Centre on the main field next to the car park.  
**Consent:** A Consent/Medical form will be sent out to those attending a week before the event.
